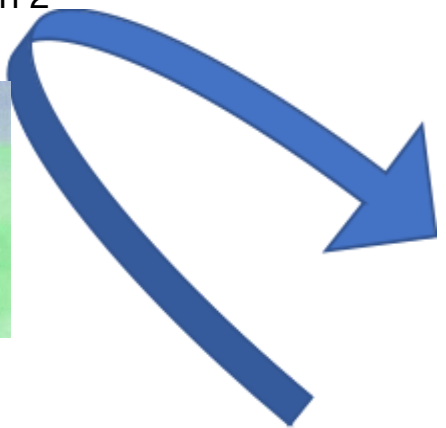
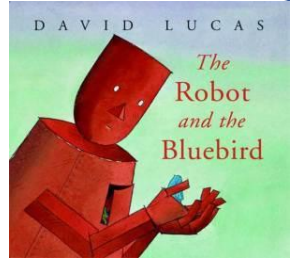


# The Priory Primary School Educational Journey

## Evaluate & Innovate

### Opportunities for Evaluation:

Final writing piece – writing a character description.  
Ability to construct a slider in a craft task.  
Understanding of different seasons – confidence to explain the types of weather you may get in different seasons and what the trees might look like at different times of the year.  
Deeper understanding of a text through role play as different characters in part of a narrative text.

### Innovation:

Make a card robot – make a slider for his broken heart.  
Use bodies to move like robots.  
Make a rain/maker/windsock/weather chart to record different aspects of the weather.  
Make a seasonal tree.



### Key Questions / Critical Thinking:

#### What makes the Seasons so Unique?

- What are the 4 different seasons?
- What do you know about the different seasons?
- What is the weather like in the different seasons?
- How do we know it is Autumn? Spring? Summer? Winter?
- What is a main character?
- Can you describe a character?
- Can you describe what a character looks/feels/smells/acts like?
- Can you explain the behaviour of the character?

### New Knowledge Learnt / Key Outcomes:

To understand main characters within a text.

Gathering information from a text about different characters.  
Construct a slider in to a system.  
Using different media tools to create a seasonal picture.
