- How can people show they value difference in school?



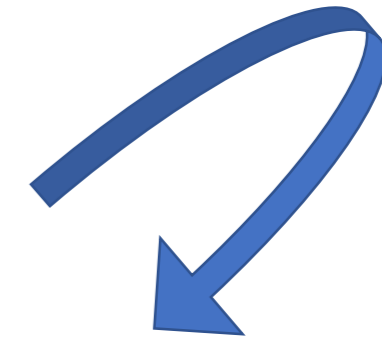
## Evaluate & Innovate
