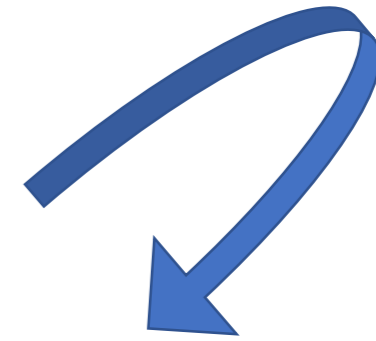
Evaluate & Innovate
