

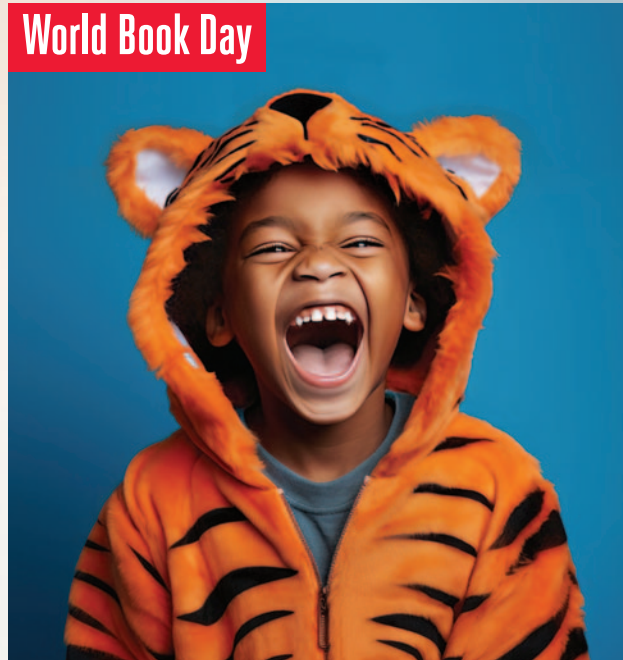

SPARKING IMAGINATIONS THROUGH DRAMA



Explorer workshops

Our popular workshops use children's natural love of drama, role-play and improvisation to spark their imaginations and stimulate their interest in Foundation, KS1 and KS2 subjects. We offer a wide range of topics each closely aligned to the National Curriculum.

Facilitated by one of our trained DBS-checked leaders, the workshops use imaginative creative resources, performing arts-based exercises and role-play scenarios to provide a new look at traditional subjects. Each workshop is different, but in general there will be:

- ▶ A quick and lively introduction to the topic.
- ▶ A physical warm-up and "ice-breaker games" to help the group connect and focus.
- ▶ An immersive and imaginative adventure; for example, you might take an imaginary time capsule back through history.
- ▶ Improvisation, role-play, freeze frames, hot seating and various other drama techniques to explore information and key facts.
- ▶ Originally written Perform songs or raps that are also great to use within the classroom for follow-up work.
- ▶ A ten question recap at the end, with a cool down to finish.

How to book

Workshops are 50 minutes each and can be combined into a:

Morning – up to 3 workshops of your choice (£280)

Full day – up to 5 workshops of your choice (£400)

Schools outside the M25 incur an additional £10 travel expenses charge.
