Reading:

Place Value

- Understand the terms integer and negative numbers

- To order and round numbers

Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication & Division

- Understand the terms factor, multiple, prime number, square number and cubed number.
- Revise and learn mental strategies to estimate and solve calculations involving all 4 operations
- Learn standard methods to solve problems involving the 4 operations

Electricity

- Use recognised symbols to represent simple series circuit diagrams
- Describe how the circuit may be affected when changes are made to it (Lighthouse)
- Planning a scientific enquiry to a question, including recognising and controlling variables where necessary (Buzzer)
- Compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches

- Understand that computers are linked via networks
- Learn how to keep safe when using computers and the internet

Programming: Variables in Games

- To define a 'variable' as something that is changeable
- To choose how to improve a game by using variables

To design a project that builds on a given example

Geography

Human Geography of the UK

- Map how land use has changed in local area over time.
- Identify the position and significance of latitude/longitude and the Greenwich Meridian.
- Describe and explore patterns in human UK geography, including: population, trade links and land use

PE

- To move into and create space to support a teammate
- To develop accuracy in the shooting action under pressure
- To use and apply skills, principles and tactics to a game situation

Tag Rugby

- To work as a defending unit to prevent attackers from scoring
